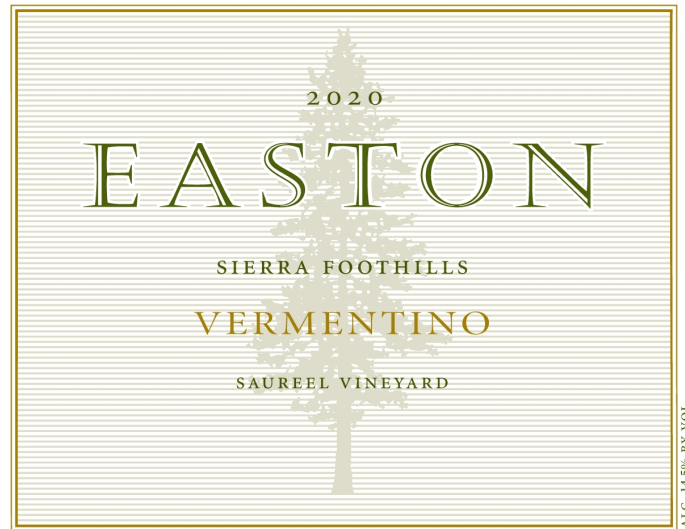

## **2021 Easton Vermentino “Saureel Vineyard” - Sierra Foothills**

Our 2021 Vermentino is made from grapes grown at the newish Saureel Vineyard on Gold Hill in El Dorado County and the Valley’s Edge Vineyard in the Shenandoah Valley. Vermentino is widely-grown grape in the Mediterranean environment. It has many aliases, but the most widely used names are Vermentino (or Vermentinu), Rolle, Pigato, and Favorita.

It is grown in Sardinia, Liguria, Corsica, and the Languedoc. It favors granitic soils, like one finds in Amador County, and the Sierra Foothills. This is a zesty, fresh wine with grapefruit and other citrusy flavors accentuated by herbal tones. It has great minerality. It is quite refreshing when served very cool. It is wonderful served with shellfish and grilled sardines or a simple rockfish that has been basted with olive oil, a squeeze of lemon, and grilled or broiled.
