2004 Terre Rouge Mourvèdre, Sierra Foothills

Mourvèdre is always the last variety that we pick for our TERRE ROUGE label. Things were no different in the great vintage of 2004 when we brought our Mourvèdre, as the last varietal, into the winery on October 8th at 25.5° brix, .65 TA, and 3.6 pH. This is a rich full-bodied vintage that is spicy, powerful, and long on the palate. We use cellaring techniques that involve a long lees reduction to help broaden and fill the middle palate with great textural sensations. The wine is aged in bottle until release several years later. The flavors are of blackberry, meaty, with an almost tomato-like Pommard quality. It is definitely gamey like Bandol, without the funkiness that Bandol, often, unfortunately offers. It is a fabulous partner for wild game, lamb, and wild salmon.
