2009 Terre Rouge Grenache Blanc, Sierra Foothills, Hawk Creek Vineyard

Our first Grenache Blanc is made from grapes grown at the cool, 2,200 foot Hawk Creek Vineyard site located near the now abandoned mining town of Coyoteville, outside of Mount Aukum at 2,200 feet in the cool, Cedar Creek Canyon. The fruit was harvested in 2009 on October 10th at 22.5° brix. Made in a vibrant, crisp, clean style. The wine is meant to be enjoyed in its' youth. It has wonderful zesty flavors that remind some of of green apple, papaya, and white peach. There is a nice expression of minerality. Reminiscent of better white Chateauneuf du Papes or or Priorat's. Refreshing; serve very cool.
