

2010 Terre Rouge Grenache Blanc, Sierra Foothills, Hawk Creek Vineyard

Our second Grenache Blanc is made from grapes grown at the cool Hawk Creek Vineyard site located near the now abandoned mining town of Coyoteville, outside of Mount Aukum at 2,200 feet in the shaded Cedar Creek Canyon. The fruit was harvested in 2010, late, on October 24th at 22.5° brix. Made in a vibrant, crisp, clean style. The wine is meant to be enjoyed in its' youth. It has wonderful zesty flavors that remind some of of green apple, papaya, and white peach. There is a nice expression of minerality. Reminiscent of better white Chateauneuf-du-Papes or or Priorats. Refreshing; serve very cool.
