

2012 Terre Rouge Grenache Blanc, Sierra Foothills, Hawk Creek Vineyard

Our fourth Grenache Blanc is made from grapes grown at the cool Hawk Creek Vineyard site located near the now abandoned mining town of Coyoteville, outside of Mount Aukum at 2,200 feet in the shaded Cedar Creek Canyon. The fruit was harvested in 2012, on October 16th at 22.0° brix. Made in a vibrant, crisp, clean style. The wine is meant to be enjoyed in its youth, but will age nicely. It has wonderful zesty flavors that remind some of of green apple, papaya, and white peach. There is a nice expression of salinity and minerality. Reminiscent of better white Chateauneuf-du-Pape or white Priorat. Medium-gold in color as is characteristic of mountain-grown Grenache Blanc that is not manipulated in the cellar. Refreshing; serve very cool.
