


TERRE ROUGE® AND EASTON WINES



2013 Easton Three of a Kind "Old Vine", Sierra Foothills, Ridgewood Vineyard (46% Cabernet Sauvignon, 38% Merlot, 16% Cabernet Franc)

Here is a one-off. We were offered the grapes from this tiny vineyard in 2014. It is a mixed planting of three Bordeaux varietals - Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, and Cabernet Franc - grown at 2,500 feet. It was planted in the 1970's about 5 miles West of Nevada City, CA in Nevada County by Ron & Katherine Goodspeed. We aged the blended wine and aged it in Bordeaux cooperage for 3 years to round-out properly. It was bottled in late November of 2017.

We think you will enjoy the wine now. It has complex aromas of black cherry, cedar and Asian black tea. Luscious and full in the mouth, it lingers nicely and reminds the drinker of certain Bordeaux's like Chateau La Conseillante that are composed of Cabernet Franc and Merlot, but here also Cabernet Sauvignon.

This wine should age nicely for several years.
