

2014 TERRE ROUGE Viognier - Fiddletown - Early Release

Just bottled in late February 2015 our new 2014 (Early Release) Viognier is organically-grown on our Fiddletown estate in granitic soils. Zesty fresh, floral, and spicy aromatics with fruit notes that suggest classic white peach and apricot flavors. This will be a perfect glass pour wine with its lively flavors. Bottled with a screw-cap closure for easy accessibility.

The grapes were harvested on September 20, 2014, a couple of weeks earlier than normal, at about 24.5 brix, whole-cluster pressed to tank; fermented to dry in stainless and then transferred to a set of older French oak barrels with a couple special new barrels from Condrieu thrown in the mix. Lees stirring, malolactic fermentation, and no racking off of primary lees are all techniques employed prior to the late February bottling.
